Neil Hammond, recently appointed by PeCAN (Petersfield Climate Action Network) to deliver this service, will give us an introductory presentation which will include case studies, financial information and ways we can be supported in assessing our best ways forward. **There will be plenty of time for questions and, we hope, some feedback from homeowners who have already accessed this service.**

This should be a highly informative evening, helping us to think more clearly about an important aspect of our lives.

This free and independent service is delivered via **phone and email**, and is supported by Hampshire County Council, Portsmouth City Council, Southampton City Council and delivered by the Southampton-based charity the Environment Centre.

Morning Prayer from Common Worship is the contemporary version of the morning daily office. It follows a pattern of introduction, psalm(s), readings, canticles including the Benedictus and prayers appropriate to the day. Currently up to 5 or 6 people might come – it is a great way to start the day and there is room for a lot more! Morning Prayer last for 20 – 25 minutes.

Some attendees of Morning Prayer, but by no means all, use the App on their phones which saves having to look up readings and psalms – it's all on the phone! How times have changed. Whether you come to church for this or not, have a look at this App – you can, of course use it anywhere!
